1. Introduction

This Bid Evaluation Report has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA) Rules, 2010, to ensure transparency, fairness, and merit-based selection in the procurement process. The report pertains to the tender for **Re-Binding of Pakistan Law Decisions (PLD) Volumes (1949–2000)** for the Court Library of the High Court of Sindh, Karachi.

The objective of this procurement is to preserve and maintain valuable legal literature by engaging a qualified and experienced firm capable of delivering durable and high-quality binding services in line with the approved specifications. The bidding process was conducted in a transparent manner, and bids were opened on **Tuesday, April 14, 2026 at 11:00 a.m.** in the office of the Director General (Finance & Accounts), in the presence of the Procurement Committee and representatives of the participating firms.

A total of two (02) bidders, namely **M/s Anas Traders** and **M/s Digi Ferry**, participated in the tender. The bids were evaluated on the basis of mandatory eligibility criteria, technical compliance, and financial competitiveness as defined in the bidding documents.

Result: Both bidders were found responsive and qualified.

4. Technical Evaluation

Both firms confirmed compliance with the required technical specifications, including:

- Hard cover binding with foamy rexine
- Minimum 40-ounce board
- Glossy paper (minimum 115 GSM)
- Enfoldment & Juzbandi stitching
- Gold embossed printing on spine
- Preservation of original text and pagination
- Availability of embossing machine

Result:

Both bidders were found **technically responsive**.

5. Financial Evaluation



M/s Anas Traders quoted the lowest rate and is approximately **36.3% lower** than M/s Digi Ferry, resulting in a financial advantage of PKR 794,500.

6. Conclusion & Recommendation

Both bidders fulfilled the mandatory and technical requirements. However, **M/s Anas Traders** emerged as the **lowest responsive bidder (L-1)** by offering the most competitive rates.

Recommendation:

The contract may be awarded to **M/s Anas Traders** in accordance with SPPRA Rules, 2010.
